

The Lyerly Town Council met for their regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, June 10, 2025 at Lyerly Town Hall. Those in attendance were:

Mayor Pro Tem Phil Brooks called the meeting to order at 7:00.

**6138 Highway 114** – Bobby at the Pure Stop wants to know if he can put a trailer beside the Pure Stop. Juanita Baker said that we wouldn't let them put one on the lot with the burnt house so we shouldn't let him put one by the Pure Stop either. Council agreed not to let him put a trailer beside the Pure Stop.

**Millage Rate for Assessment Notices** – Clerk Sally Kerce explained that we are not setting the millage rate for our taxes yet. The assessors just want us to set a tentative millage rate to go on the assessments. The county will give us numbers in a few months and a suggested rollback rate but we can still set the millage rate at whatever they want to. Council discussed it and agreed to leave it the same as last year which is 6.75%. Juanita Baker made a motion to set the millage rate for assessment notices at 6.75%. Gwen Fisher seconded. All in favor.

Shirley Davis said that she would like to address something. She said that they voted last year that if anyone wants to set up and sell anything, they would have to set up at the new parking lot beside the park. She said that we had someone who set up at the Ragland building a few weeks ago. She said it doesn't upset her too much that people set up on the gravel lot at the Ragland building but she thinks that we spent too much money to let people set up under the porch and sell stuff. Juanita Baker said that she doesn't see a problem with people in the gravel lot but not under the porch of the Ragland building. Shirley Davis said that if the community center is rented, there isn't room for anyone to set up. She said that we need to leave it so that they can set up at the parking lot at the park or not at all. Everyone agreed.

Mayor Ferguson came in late. Phil Brooks explained everything that they had discussed.

Phil Brooks made the motion to adjourn. Gwen Fisher seconded. All in favor.
